## This week in a nutshell

Mental multiplication and division focuses on dividing multiples of 10 or 100 by another multiple of 10 or 100.

Written multiplication and division involves children using and applying their knowledge of the inverse relationship between multiplication and division.

Written addition and subtraction extends to numbers with up to 7 digits.
Subtraction of fractions with different denominators is introduced for the first time this week, but in this week's questions, one denominator will always be a simple multiple of the other.
