Grammar:

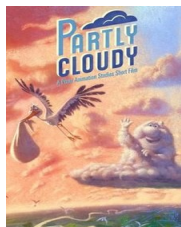
Complete pages 56 in your CGP books on punctuating speech.

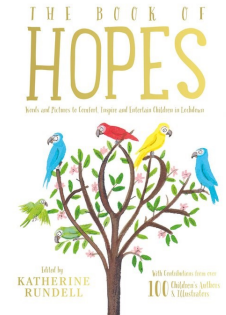

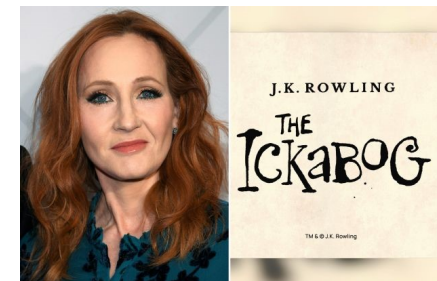

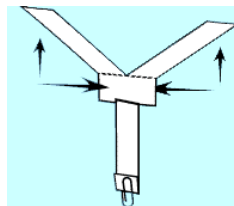


Science:
