<b>Monotheism</b>	Belief in 1 God
<b>Polytheism</b>	Belief in many Gods/Goddesses
<b>Trimurti</b>	The Gods Vishnu, Brahma and Shiva make up three aspects of the universal supreme God
<b>Tridevi</b>	The goddesses Saraswati, Lakshmi and Shakti are the three equally important female aspects of the universal supreme God.
<b>Dharma</b>	Hindus must follow the right moral path and take their duties seriously.
<b>Reincarnation</b>	All living things have a soul that can not be destroyed.
<b>Moksha</b>	The ultimate goal for all Hindus. It is a liberation from the cycle of rebirth and death.
<b>Diwali</b>	A Hindu holy festival celebrating the triumph of good over evil.
<b>Diya</b>	Lamps that are lit during Diwali
