<p style="text-align: center;"><u>How special is the relationship Jews have with God?</u></p> <p>Moses was given the Ten Commandments and God asked the Jewish people to live by these as their promise to him.</p> <p>A <b>prayer shawl</b> has ten knots as a reminder of the Ten Commandments.</p> <p>Jews believe that <b>the Torah</b> shows how God wants Jews to live. It contains 613 commandments and Jews refer to the ten best known of these as the ten 10 statements.</p> <p>The <b>Shema</b> is a declaration that Jewish people should love God and keep his rules. It is regarded by many Jews as the most important prayer in Judaism.
