Our focus Bible study will be Luke 24: 1-49







Key events:

Holy Week—the week before Easter, starting on Palm Sunday

Palm Sunday—the first day of Holy Week and celebrates Jesus' arrival into Jerusalem. Crowds of people went to see him and threw palm branches into the road.

Maundy Thursday—the day Jesus at his Passover meal with his disciples, called The Last Supper.

Good Friday—the day that Jesus was crucified, Christians commemorate this day in church

Easter Sunday—this day marks the resurrection of Jesus . Jesus appeared to his disciple on this day and for forty days after.
