#### Understanding of the World

In Science this term, we will be looking at everyday materials. The children will be able to identify and compare different materials and see how the shapes of solid objects, made from certain materials, can be changed through squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

In R.E we will be exploring the questions 'Who made the world?' Looking at Gospels and 'What good news does Jesus bring?'

In History we will be answering the question 'What was the impact of the great fire of London?' We will explore this through Samuel Pepys diaries about the great fire of London in 1666.

In Computing this term, we be learning about how we can stay safe when using the Internet, online relationships, being kind online and who our trusted adults are.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development We will be covering what it is like to be ourselves and how we might be different to others and why this should be celebrated.
