## RE

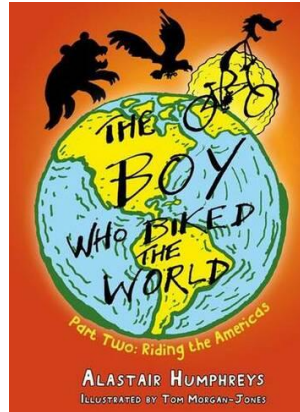
