English

- To join word and clauses with the word 'and, so and but'.
- To develop our use of question marks.
- To continue to identify the difference between capital letters and lower case letters.
- Identifying and writing in the present and past tense.

In Phonics this term the following areas will be covered through the use of Sounds Write:

- Continuing the Sounds Write extended code.
- Applying our phonic skills to decode real and alien words.
- To decode and blend polysyllabic words.
- Focusing on our year 1 common exception words.

Creative Development

In DT this term we will be exploring where our food is made and how to prepare simple dishes without heat. We will be using chopping, grating, slicing and many other skills to help us create a simple food dish. We will also be looking at different foods from around the world and how it differs to what we eat regularly.
