Key Vocabulary

Christians	People who believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, and who follow his teachings and those of the Christian churches.
Bible	The Bible is the holy book for Christians
Zacchaeus	Unpopular tax collector who Jesus befriended
Mary and Martha	Sisters and brother who were friends of Jesus
Lazarus	Brother to Mary and Martha, and friend of Jesus. Christians believe Jesus brought Lazarus back from the dead
Friendship	Means caring about another person and that they care for you
Qualities of Friendship	Some of the qualities that a good friendship has are: love, trust, support and helpfulness.

By the end of the unit children pupils will be expected to: Give a clear, simple account of 3 different stories of from the New Testament and explain how Jesus showed friendship in them. To be able to talk about the different qualities of friendship and how they show them. Give examples of ways in which Christians show friendship and how God helps them to do this. Decide what they personally think about what makes a good friendship how easy or hard it can be to show friendship in different circumstances.
