

Our Planet

The world is made up of land and oceans. The land is grouped into **continents**. There are 7 continents—can you name these? Each continent is made up of different **countries**

There are 5 **oceans**—**Arctic, Atlantic, Pacific, Indian** and **Southern**. Some people say there are 7 oceans as they divide the Atlantic and Pacific into North and South.



What is climate?

Climate is what the weather is like most of the time. There are different types of climate in each continent. This is affected by how close the continent is to the equator.

The climate in Europe is **temperate**—what do you think this means? Think about what the weather is like throughout the seasons and about our location from the **equator**.

Climate Change

The earth's climate has seen many changes in its 4.55 billion years. For example, 18,000 years ago most of Britain was covered in ice and glaciers.

Although changes to the earth's climate are **natural**, current changes are a result of increasing **human** populations and activities.
