## English

We will focus on non-fiction writing. We will write reports and persuasive speeches, using the news and Greta Thunberg's speeches as inspiration.

Later in the term we will be writing poetry using nature and the weather. We will be continuing with our grammar and spelling lessons each week.

## Geography

We will be using maps, atlases and globes to increase our geographical knowledge and geographical vocabulary. We will study the main features of our planet and how climate change is impacting that. We will also study rivers. This includes the main features and revision of the water cycle.

## RE

We will be focusing on Christianity this term, both the Old and New Testament. We will be continuing to learn about Jesus and then delving deeper into the book of Genesis and its meaning to Christians.

## Computing

We will continue to develop our understanding of internet safety through Safer Internet Day activities and learning how to manage online information. We will also be learning how to programme using Python.

We will also focus on angles, using protractors to measure and draw them, as well as calculating them. We will continue to develop our problem solving and reasoning skills throughout the term.

## Science

Our focus this term is biology. First we will be classifying a range of animals and plants by creating our own classification keys. Later in the term we will be learning about evolution and inheritance. We will learn about the scientists Charles Darwin and Mary Anning.

## Art and DT

We will look at different collage techniques and use the environment as our inspiration to create our own collage artwork. Our DT will be woodworking, creating a moving mechanism using a cam.

## French

We will be learning about the weather. We will build on previous learning of days of the week and months of the year. We will write and present weather reports.
