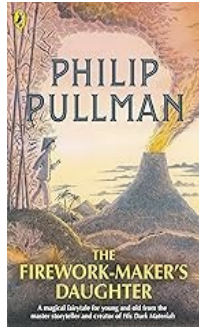


English

We have been learning about column addition and subtraction and how to use exchanges across 10 and 100 using 3 digit numbers.

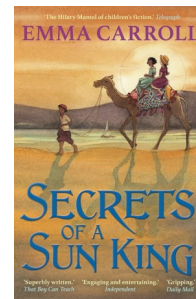
The children have been enjoying the table races each week and they are all progressing well. Keep practicing!
