Sounds Write Books

- The books are carefully designed to match what your child has already been taught.
- They may look simple, but your child must decode around 90% of the words independently.
- This level of independence is crucial for:
 - Confidence
 - Fluency
 - Enjoyment

- Broad and balanced curriculum

 - History – What was the impact of the Great Fire of London?
 - Science – What are things made from and why?
 - RE – Who made the world?
