Key Vocabulary	
Country	A land that is controlled by one group of government.
Continent	A large solid area of land. (Europe, Asia, Africa, North and South America, Australia, Antarctica).
Ocean	A huge body of saltwater.
Climate	A weather pattern lasting over a long time.
Temperature	A degree of hotness or coldness.
Globe	A sphere on which a map of the world is shown.
Equator	An imaginary circle around the world. It splits the world into 2 equal parts.
Compass	A tool which shows people which direction they are travelling in and helps them find their way.
