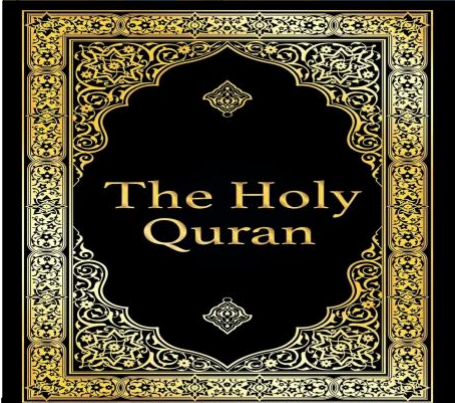
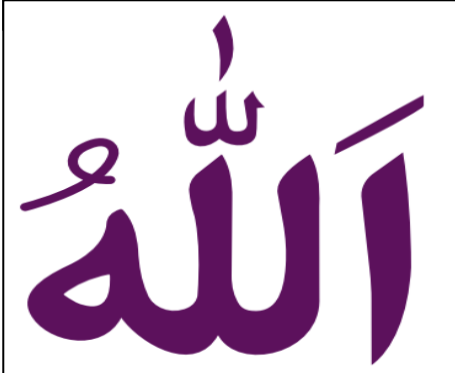
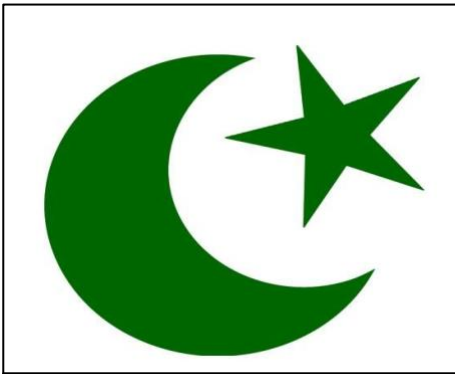


Year 2 RE – Islam: Does praying at regular intervals help Muslims in their everyday lives?

Ka'bah	Building in Makkah which Muslims face in prayer.
Pilgrimage	A special or religious journey.
Hajj	Pilgrimage to Makkah – Muslims are expected to go once in a lifetime if possible.
Qur'an	The Holy book for Muslims – words of Allah to Muslims.
Mosque	A Muslim place of worship.
Prayer mat	A small carpet used by Muslims for kneeling on when prayer.
