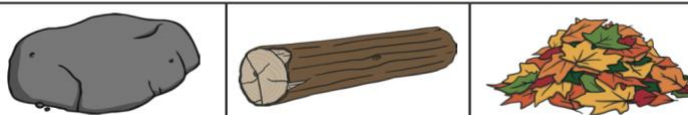

Key Vocabulary

Habitat	The natural place in which something lives. A habitat provides living things with everything they need to survive.
Microhabitat	A very small habitat that minibeasts live in.
Environment	The surroundings of living things, including both living and non-living things. It includes the air, water, land, plants, and animals.
Characteristic	A distinguishing feature or quality of an organism. Characteristics can be used to identify and classify living things.
Living	Animals and plants are living things. Living things need to have their basic needs met to survive.
Survive	To survive means to stay alive.
