RE

We will be learning about Muslims and how they show commitment to God. In addition, we will be delving deeper into the teachings of Jesus from the Bible.

Science

We will start the year with our BBVS Science Fair which will be based around the Titanic. Once we have completed our investigations and experiments, we will present our work to the whole school.

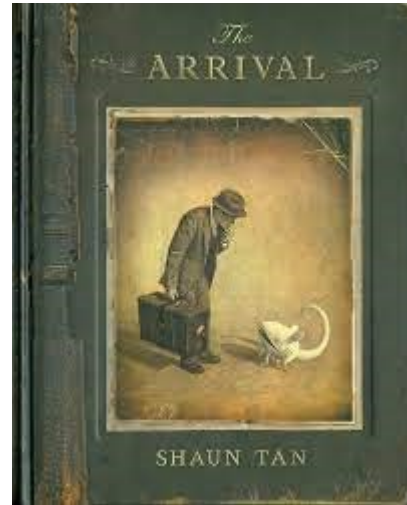
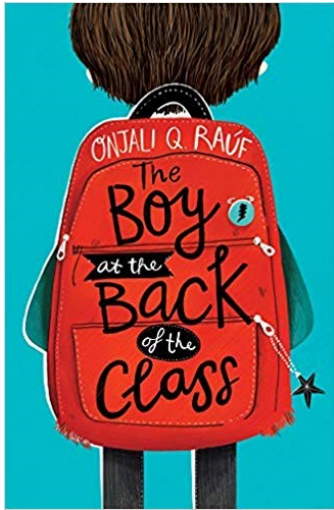
**PE will be on Tuesday and Friday.

Spelling tests will happen each Friday and new spellings will be sent home the same day. Please ensure your child practises these at home alongside regular reading.

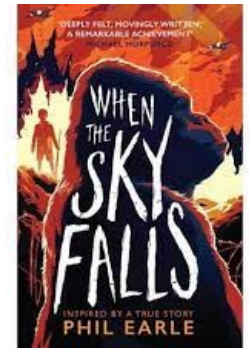
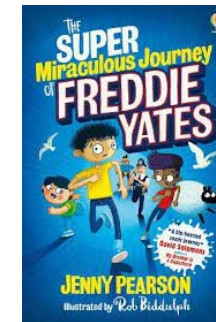
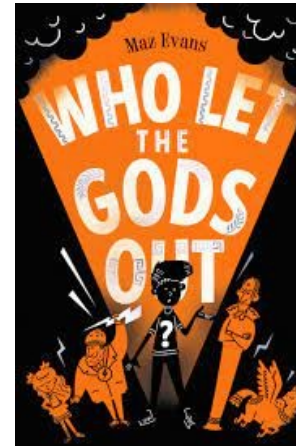
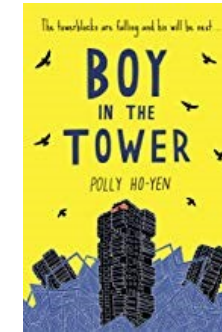
