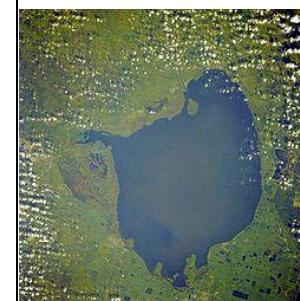
Understand geographical similarities and differences

Climate zones: the weather changes in different parts of the world. Similar patterns = climate.

Vegetation belts: type of plant life in a certain area

Biomes: Biomes are areas of our planet with similar climates, landscapes, animals and plants.

Settlements: Settlements are places where people live and sometimes work. They can be small or large depending on how many people live there and how many facilities there are.

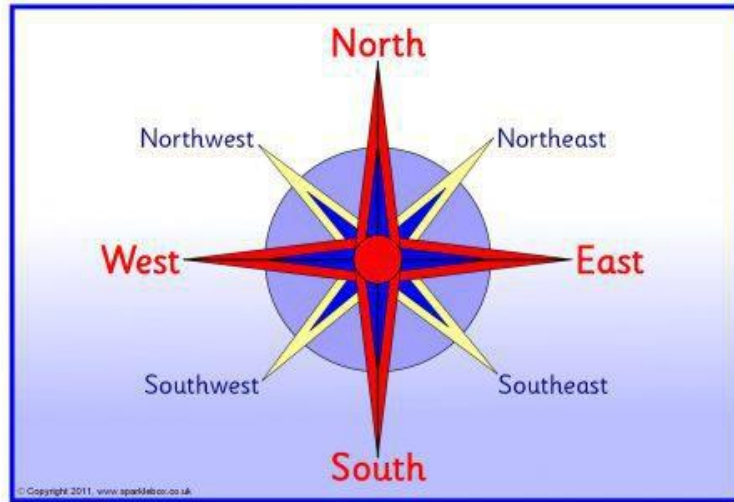
