#### **Reading Questions:**

- How many people have already travelled to space?
- What do we know about space? Can you name the planets in our solar system?
- What do you know about the sun? What do you know about Earth's moon? Space often refers to everything in the Universe beyond planet Earth.
- How do you think we know about space?
- What we can see, the use of telescopes, sending space probes, sending people into space etc.

Look at RESOURCE 7 which gives information about some of the people who have travelled to space. Focus on the number of people who have travelled to space since the first person in 1961.

- Does any of the information surprise you? What questions do you have?
- What do you think will happen to this number once commercial flights are introdued? Do you think it will increase at a more rapid rate or do you think the cost of the flights will cause it not to?
- Because people have travelled to space, do you think we know or understand all there is to know about space? Why/why not?
- Would you prefer to go to space as an astronaut working to discover and learn more, on a commercial flight to enjoy the experience or would you prefer not to go at all!


