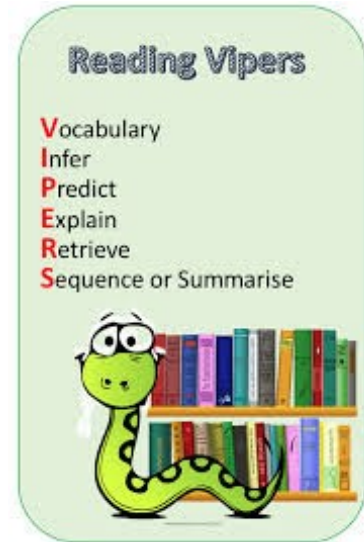


Week 4 Reading Vipers

Alonso	King of Naples

- Q6. What does Ferdinand mean when he says 'Devils! Devils in the rigging!?' (Explain)
- Q7. Find a synonym for pull. (Vocabulary)
- Q8. What evidence is there that the storm is violent? Give 3 pieces of evidence. (Retrieve)
- Q9. Summarise Act I Scene I in 2 sentences. (Summarise)
- Q10. What other stories, poems or plays do you know that involve a storm at sea?
